- ► This product is intended for residential indoor use only. It is only warranted for indoor installation in a climate controlled environment.
- ▶ Do not store at temperatures below 32 degrees Fahrenheit.

Unpacking the Unit

- 1. Inspect the Carton.
- 2. If you note carton damage, take a picture, note the delivery receipt as damaged and contact the dealer or Hastings immediately. **Do not install a damaged product. Hastings is not responsible for damage during transit.**
- 3. Immediately inspect the unit for damage even if there is no visible carton damage and immediately report any damage to the distributor or manufacturer customer service at 1-800-351-0038. Once the unit is installed and there is surface damage visible, we will assume it was caused by the installer. Installers are responsible for damage that occurs once the unit is set in place. Installation constitutes acceptance.
- 4. Remove all packaging material except for the protective foam covering. The protective foam covering was put on the product to help eliminate abrasions due to handling and should not be removed until you are ready to inspect or just prior to installation.

Installation and Operation Guidelines

Read all instructions before installing the product. Installer/product owner is responsible for complying with all state and local codes. Hastings strongly recommends using licensed professionals to install these products. Warning: Certain cleaning products will permanently damage the cosmetic surface of the product. Read cleaning product instruction carefully before using. Never use anything abrasive, aerosol sprays, or metal scrapers.

BEFORE INSTALLING:

Remove the protective plastic and inspect the product thoroughly. The protective plastic was put on the product to help prevent abrasions/staining, and the cosmetic surface of the product should be protected in some manner after the protective plastic is removed. A factory defect must be reported to the manufacturer before the product is installed. Defects or damage claimed after installation will be excluded from the warranty.


Important: Measure the product on site carefully. Hastings is NOT responsible for any preparatory labor or materials.

Warning: Some Vanities and tops may be very heavy. Make sure you have adequate help to move/install them before beginning. Hastings is not responsible for handling damage.

ATTENTION INSTALLER!



Installation Planning and Preparation




Typical tools needed provided by installer

• Rough plumbing and product size details can be found on the product Spec sheet. One drawer and two drawer models have thick and thin top options, check the spec sheets for details on your cabinet and top.




Two Drawer thin top example




One Drawer thin top example


- Check to make sure the wall is flat with no belly or wave in the wall material. All wall material should be flat and permanently bonded. Any tile should be left to dry for a week before installing the vanity.
- For tile or stone walls, a hammer drill and masonry drill bit may be needed




• Locate the top of the vanity and the center of the sink aligned with the drain location on the wall.



• Mark the wall with the vanity position and measure as described above to locate the wall mount brackets, double check all measurements and attached the brackets to the wall.







Adjust the cabinet latch outward to stick out from the cabinet with screw number 2.

Screw number 1 is used to level the box.

Hanging the Cabinet


- Hang the cabinet on the wall, be sure to hear the latch click into place.
- Adjust the latch as shown to level the cabinet and pull it into the wall. Be careful not to overtighten as doing so may rack or twist the cabinet box out of square.






• Once adjusted into the final position install the decorative cover caps

INSTALLING THE COUNTERTOP



- It is recommended to install the faucet onto the countertop before the top is placed on the cabinet.
- If an overflow is included with your product install the overflow assembly and connections at this time.
- Using a neutral clear silicone apply two small beads as shown on each side of the cabinet. Double sided tape may be used instead of silicone.
- With two people lower the top in place taking care to center it on the vanity. Tape in place using a painter's safe tape until silicone is dry.
- Install the Plumbing and drain using standard plumbing practices. Note: It is recommended to use clear silicone as your drain seal as plumbers' putty may stain the matte solid surface top.
- If needed drawers can be adjusted or removed as shown below.





Cleaning and Maintenance

Cleaning Instructions for Solid Surface Tops

The cast surface of all Hastings Products solid surface is one of the highest quality surfaces available. The matte finish is design to provide an elegant, durable finish. Its hard, non-porous surface prevents dirt from accumulating and resists stains. Under normal use, the solid surface will retain its beauty with only a minimal amount of care. To maintain the elegant look, follow these simple steps:

Construction Debris: Most construction debris can be removed with a mild detergent. More stubborn debris may be removed with denatured alcohol or Clorox Soft Scrub® cleaner. Plaster can be removed by carefully using a sharpened wooden stick. **Do not use metal scrapers, wire brushes, or other harsh abrasive tools.** Light scratches and dulled areas may be restored to original MATTE finish by lightly sanding the area with #320 dry grit sandpaper.

Remove dust and dry dirt with a soft, damp cloth. To remove most stains, use Mr. Clean Magic Eraser. Clean grease, oil, paint, or ink stains with isopropyl (rubbing) alcohol. Dry with a clean, soft cloth.

Avoid using razor blades or other sharp objects that might scratch the surface. Most minor scratches (up to 1/64") and cigarette burns can be removed on the matte finish tops by sanding the area with #320 dry grit sandpaper. For cracks and glossy surface damage, call our service line (800) 351-0038 for information.

Glass and Porcelain Countertops

Normal cleaners safe for glass or mirrors can be used.
Surface should be dried with a soft lint free cloth.
Products must not contain ammonia, alcohol, or harsh detergents
No abrasive cleaners should be used.
Take care not to let the cleaner come in contact with finished painted surfaces.

Vanity Cleaning and Maintenance

Only use nonabrasive furniture safe cleaners, no alcohol or ammonia cleaners should ever be used. Always dry with a soft lint free cloth. Never allow soapy residue to dry on the cabinet and drawer finish.



LIMITED WARRANTY

All Hastings Vanities and tops are warranted in accordance with the following Limited Warranty:

Hastings Vanities and tops are warranted against defects in material and workmanship from the date of the first consumer purchase.

The manufacturer warranty is 1 year against defects. This Warranty shall apply to defective surfaces which crack, fade or blister.

The Warranty extends to the first consumer purchaser and not to subsequent owners, transferees or users other than the first purchaser. This warranty does not extend to products previously utilized as display models.

This Warranty shall apply to products installed and used only for indoor personal, family or household purposes and which are installed and maintained in accordance with Hastings recommended installation and maintenance procedures. This Warranty does not extend to defects or damage caused, in whole or in part, by any unauthorized or unreasonable use such as misuse, abuse, negligence or accidental damages resulting from customer or installer. No liability shall exist for incidental or consequential damages caused in whole or part by any defects in Hastings products. No warranty, expressed or implied, including any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, shall apply after the warranty period described above. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages or limitations on how long an implied warranty last. The above limitation may not apply to you.

In the event of a defect in material or workmanship of a Hastings Bath distributed product during the Warranty period, defective products will be repaired or replaced by Hastings, at its sole and absolute discretion. However, Hastings shall not be liable for the expense for removing defective products or installing replacement products. In certain circumstances, some states do not allow the limitation of liability for removal, transportation and reinstallation expenses. The above limitation may not apply to you.

Only Hastings is authorized to perform its warranty obligation. If you wish to obtain performance of the Hastings warranty obligation you should contact Hastings, telephone number 800-351-0038.
